Rehearsal Suggestions

A minor key version of “Deck the Halls” serves as the basis of this tongue-in-cheek holiday novelty. Your ensemble should play in a marcato style throughout the piece. Carefully observe dynamics, especially where they are softer (measure 7). Emphasize dissonance where it occurs (mm. 23-24) and make sure the trombones are prominent whenever they gliss (mm. 23, 24, 44, 46, and 47). The most dramatic portion of the piece (mm. 39-48) should start softly. Maintain the intensity throughout this section, gradually building to the dissonant climax at m. 48. Make sure the percussion breaks (mm. 33-34 and 37-38) are noisy and boisterous. You can add additional percussion here if you wish. M. 49 should be a complete change of pace, played warmly, in a legato style. Following the *ritard* at m. 56, return to the original aggressive and marcato style of the beginning. Exaggerate the dramatic moments in the work, and above all, HAVE FUN!



About the Composer



Larry Neeck is an internationally recognized composer and arranger, with more than one-hundred eighty works for concert band, jazz ensemble, and orchestra published by C.L. Barnhouse Company and Arco String Publications. He is frequently commissioned to write for schools, bands, and festivals, and often works as a guest conductor and clinician. His CDs, “Swing Machine,” recorded by the Studio A Big Band, and “Midnight Escape,” recorded by the Washington Winds are available from Walking Frog Records. His music has been heard on PBS television, and he has received numerous ASCAP awards for his compositions.

In addition to his work as a composer, Mr. Neeck had a successful career as a middle school band director, retiring after thirty-two years from the Webster (NY) Central School District. He directed concert bands, jazz ensembles, taught wind and percussion classes, and co-founded the Willink Middle School Student/Parent Band. He is currently the conductor of the Eastman-Rochester New Horizons Band at the Eastman School of Music. The years he spent as a school band director have informed his composing style, resulting in works that engage students and audiences alike.

Mr. Neeck holds a B.A. in Music from the University of Pittsburgh, and an M.M. in Music Education from the Eastman School of Music. He is a member of the American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP), National Association for Music Education (NAfME), New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA), and the New York State Band Directors Association (NYSBDA).
