### Program Notes

**March Of The Penguins** is a fun light-hearted selection which brings to life the story of the Emperor penguin. Emperor penguins are the only penguins to raise their young during the Antarctic winter. The male emperors exit the sea in March, and head for their breeding grounds. The Emperors march in a single file line that can contain thousands of individuals. Most of these penguins breed on fast ice along the coast. Some emperor penguins march as much as 70 miles; perhaps they are getting ready to strike up the band!

### Rehearsal Suggestions

If you do not have Jingle Bells or a Cabasa, these instruments can be substituted. A suspended cymbal can be substituted for the Jingle Bells, and a Tambourine can be substituted for the Cabasa. It is important to pay very close attention to the dynamics and articulation for the most effective performance. At m. 9 the flute has the melody, so be careful to balance the band so the melody is prominent. At m. 42 this melody moves to the low winds. Ensure good balance so the low winds melody can easily be heard. From m. 50 to the end, each measure needs to be softer until the last measure is played at a tutti piano.

I hope you and your students enjoy **March Of The Penguins**.

Todd received a Bachelor of Science in Music Education from Indiana University-Purdue University, Fort Wayne and a Master of Arts in Music from Ball State University. He has also continued his education at the Vandercook College of Music.

As a freelance musician, Todd has been featured on his trumpet, keyboard, and trombone in groups ranging from the nationally known Sammy Kay Orchestra to the Box Tops and as the opening act for Three Dog Night. He regularly plays around the Fort Wayne area with numerous groups and as a solo artist. Todd also lends his talents to two contemporary church groups and the Fort Wayne Area Community Band.
