Program Note

This composition takes its inspiration from a poignant childhood memory of composer Jessica L. Mullen. As a young child, she heard a story about the volcanoes dotting the landscape on the West Mesa overlooking Albuquerque, New Mexico. While the story filled her with awe and wonder, it also instilled a deep sense of fear in her. However, her wise and loving grandmother reassured her that the volcanoes were sleeping and not immediately dangerous. These words of comfort stayed with the composer, eventually leading her to create this piece in tribute to her beloved grandmother. Although the music is about dormant volcanoes, it also symbolizes how sharing your fears with a trusted person can ease your worries.

Rehearsal Suggestions

Attention to balance, dynamic contrast, and proper articulation is essential throughout this piece. During the introduction, maintain a careful balance to hear the exchange between the winds and percussion. The upper woodwinds play the initial statement of the theme, leading into measure 5. The low woodwinds should lead the crescendo into m. 9. The balance between the melody and accompanying figures is crucial so that the moving parts in the brass are audible. As the dynamics change and new layers are added to the overall texture, attention to balance should continue throughout the work. At m. 21, there should be a noticeable stylistic change with the introduction of staccato articulations. The theme is then presented twice more, leading into m. 37, with the entire composition building up to the downbeat of m. 41. From m. 45 to the end, the music should have a sense of calm and peace as it draws to a close.

I hope you enjoy rehearsing and performing *El Volcán Duerme*.

Since then, she has written music for her elementary music ensembles, several chamber works, electronic music, and music for band.
