About the Music

Liturgical ceremonies throughout the year provide images of beautiful lights in sacred and solemn remembrance. Using the shimmering of candles as a musical metaphor, composer Robert W. Smith has created this beautiful composition inspired by candlelit vespers during the holidays, Easter and other times of the year. Through shimmering trills in the woodwinds to lush harmonies and chordal dissonances in the full band, **Vespers Of Light** is a quiet and reflective musical experience for all.

Notes to Conductor


Harmonic balance is the key to a successful performance of this piece. For example, in m. 1, the Eb major chord supports the melodic line. In m. 2, the Eb major continues to sustain in the trumpets while the remainder of the band drops to a Db major chord. The balance between the two triads is critical to the overall effect. This polytonality experience provides an excellent teaching opportunity for the developing musician.

The trills in the woodwinds should be gentle throughout alluding to the shimmering of light from candles in a liturgical ceremony. Please note all trills are diatonic. This will allow the introduction and reinforcement of whole step trills.

I have carefully notated dynamic shaping throughout. Please ask the musicians to pay special attention to the shape of the decrescendo. The interpretation should be more rounded avoiding a subito drop in dynamic level.

Stagger breathing will be very important throughout. Please ask the musicians to stagger breathe unless a rest is notated. Lower woodwinds that may have only one on a part should stagger breathe with each other as well as the tuba to insure the presence of the bass line.

Vespers Of Light is written as a musically mature work for the developing band. It is my hope the musicians will enjoy the challenge and find the beauty of lyricism in their musical performance. Best wishes for a wonderful performance!

Robert W. Smith (b. 1958) is one of the most popular and prolific composers in America today. He has over 600 publications in print with the majority composed and arranged through his long association with Warner Bros. Publications and the Belwin catalog.

Mr. Smith's credits include many compositions and productions in all areas of the music field. His original

works for winds and percussion have been programmed by countless military, university, high school, and middle school bands throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, South America and Asia. His Symphony #1 (The Divine Comedy), Symphony #2 (The Odyssey), Symphony #3 (Don Quixote), Inchon and Africa: Ceremony, Song and Ritual have received worldwide critical acclaim. His educational compositions such as The Tempest, Encanto, and The Great Locomotive Chase have become standards for developing bands throughout the world.

Mr. Smith's music has received extensive airplay on major network television as well as inclusion in multiple motion pictures. From professional ensembles such as the United States Navy Band, United States Air Force Band, Boston Pops and the Atlanta Symphony to school bands and orchestras throughout the world, his music speaks to audiences in any concert setting. As a conductor, clinician and keynote speaker, Mr. Smith has performed throughout North America, Asia, South America, Europe and Australia. His music has been recorded by various ensembles and is available on CD and download through Walking Frog Records, iTunes, Amazon, and other recorded music outlets.

In addition, he is currently teaching in the Music Industry program at Troy University in Troy, Alabama. His teaching responsibilities are focused in music composition, production, publishing and business.
