About the Composer



John Prescott is Professor of Music at Missouri State University where he teaches music theory, composition, and coordinates Graduate Studies in Music. His compositions are published by Balquhidder Music, Claude T. Smith Publications, the International Trombone Association Press, JPM Publications, TRN Publications, and Wingert-Jones Publications.

Dr. Prescott holds degrees from Florida State University and the University of Kansas where he studied composition with John Pozdro and James Barnes. He

is a member of American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP), the Missouri Music Educators Association (MMEA), and the National Association for Music Education (NAfME).

Program Notes

This composition was written in 1993 to honor the career of Robert M. (Bob) Scott upon the occasion of his retirement from Southwest Missouri State University. He served as Director of Bands, Music Department Head, and finally as Dean of Arts and Letters, and in 1986 he gave me the chance to realize my dream of being a university music theory and composition teacher.

The music attempts to capture the dignity of the man while also expressing the powerful emotions connected with being part of a wind and percussion band. The composition was first published in 1997, and I am thrilled it is now being republished in a new, improved edition by Claude T. Smith Publications, Inc.

The title of this work is taken from a fragment of a poem, reprinted below. Bob Scott wrote me after the music's initial publication to tell me that during his days as a high school band director they really did march through neighborhoods to get to their practice field.

THE HIGH SCHOOL BAND IN SEPTEMBER

On warm days in September the high school band
Is up with the birds and marches along our street,
Boom boom,
To a field where it goes boom boom until eight forty-five
When it marches, as in the old rhyme, back, boom boom,
To its study halls, leaving our street
Empty except for the leaves that descend to no drum
And lie still.
In September
A great many high school bands beat a great many drums,
And the silences after their partings are very deep.

Rehearsal Suggestion

At measure 19, the Alto Saxophone 1 part has the melody and has been purposefully marked one dynamic level louder than the accompanying parts. This voice should be more prominent and allowed to be easily heard. While minor tempo fluctuations in this section are to be expected for expressive purposes, care must be taken to not allow the tempo to slow significantly.
