### PROGRAM NOTE

To live "above the line", we must hold ourselves to a higher standard, particularly in our words and actions. The study of music and performance is a powerful means to teach the value of teamwork and personal integrity, especially when faced with challenges. Those who study music learn to express themselves through their art while developing the personal skills and ethics to become outstanding citizens. Our musicians are positive, productive individuals who live *Above the Line*.

### NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

I have notated articulations throughout to bring excitement and energy to the musical performance. Emphasize weight on accents and space after the marcato markings.

Dynamic contrast throughout is also very important. For instance, the mezzo-piano notated in the first two strains should be a noticeable contrast, while maintaining style and tempo.

Beginning in measure 91, the trumpets have an important fanfare that should be balanced for presence and clarity.

Bass line instruments should note the difference in note lengths and accents where weight should be placed, such as chromatic passing tones.

It is my hope that *Above the Line* will be a fun and exciting addition to your next program. Best wishes for an outstanding performance!
