PROGRAM NOTE

Adventure Awaits captures the excitement felt at the start of something new! The composer writes, “In creating this piece, I found myself imagining the many stories of long journeys told in books, television, movies, and beyond – some fantastical, and some based in reality. In addition to drawing on these sources of inspiration, I hope performers and audience members alike draw on their own adventurous experiences, recalling those positive feelings at the beginning of exciting personal journeys!”

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

This concert opener was written with the young band at the front of mind, with careful attention to range, rhythmic challenge, and length of phrase. A largely consistent percussion presence throughout can be helpful in ensuring ensemble vertical alignment. Additionally, considerations have been taken to ensure playability with limited instrumentation.

The key to a successful performance is the interpretation of stylistic elements, including accented notes, which are intended to be emphasized more than those notes around them. Be sure to perform unmarked eighth notes in a “lifted” style! However, be cautious not to perform these lifted notes, and other “short” notes so short as to impair the production of tone.

From a balance perspective, it is key that ostinato figures, when present, do not overpower the melody! Additionally, be sure to encourage performers to pay special attention to the lengths of notes followed by rest, ensuring that these notes are played for their full rhythmic durations!

Finally, I encourage you to take full advantage of the dynamic contrasts, particularly any sudden dynamic contrasts, written into the music.

Evan VanDoren is a freelance arranger, composer, and educational consultant. As the owner of VanDoren Music, Evan is commissioned each year to create works for concert and marching ensembles. He has arranged and orchestrated award-winning marching shows for numerous high school bands across the country.

Evan is an active clinician, presenting for Drum Corps International, the Music Educators National Convention, the Texas Bandmasters Association, the Texas Music Educators Association, and Music for All. He regularly consults with band programs around the country.
