PROGRAM NOTE

This arrangement of the traditional Christmas carol *Silent Night* has been set in the soothing Brazilian style of Bossa Nova. Known for its rich, lush harmonies and mellow, warm vibe, Bossa Nova features Latin percussion instruments that complement this unique setting of the peaceful carol. Please sit back, relax and enjoy this tranquil setting of the beautiful Christmas lullaby.

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

Check the marked tempo and keep the pulse steady. All students should listen throughout to the cabasa (Percussion 3) to help them subdivide the beat and create the proper stylistic feel. Choose a student with consistent time for this part and stress how important their role is to the groove. The cabasa is the glue that holds it all together.

Have your snare drum player play the ride cymbal. Note the indications for the dome of the cymbal. The player should strike the dome with the side of the stick as notated.

Play some recordings of famous Bossa Nova music so your young musicians will have a stylistic model. Antonio Carlos Jobim is a good place to start.

Work on getting a warm, soft, gentle tone. Introduce and reinforce their performance in a “laid-back” manner to create a mellow, peaceful, relaxing vibe.

I encourage you to carefully balance the ensemble in order for the lush harmonies to speak properly. Also, please ensure your players know when they have the melody (or not).

Special attention should be given to all dynamics and articulations in order to maximize the dramatic effect of the piece.

I hope your young musicians squeeze the potential out of this Latin arrangement of *Silent Night*. Boa Sorte (Good luck)!

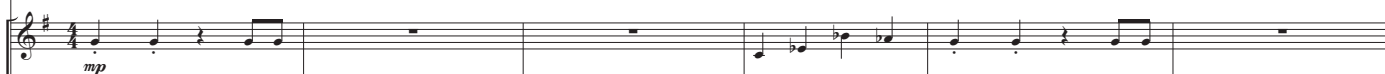
