PROGRAM NOTE

A flaming ball of fire bolting across the night sky is truly an amazing sight. It is always a magical moment when we witness a “shooting star”. It fills us with wonder and makes us feel special to have caught just a glimpse. So special, in fact, that it inspires most of us to make a wish. The song you are about to hear is a musical depiction of these inspiring celestial events. Feel free to make your own wish as we perform **Firebolt**.

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

Check the marked tempo and keep the pulse steady. Feel free to adjust for rehearsal efficiency as your students develop their skills.

The winds and percussion interact throughout. Be sure to balance accordingly.

Use this piece to work on rhythmic clarity and stabilizing the embouchure. There are many repeated notes. Remind your students to keep their embouchures stable to keep from scooping the notes.

In measures 17-37, keep the pulse of the ostinato pattern steady to propel the piece forward. Pay special attention to the length of the staccato eighth notes. The quarter notes should be tongued, unaccented and receive full value.

Unified articulations are of utmost importance. Challenge your students to listen carefully and strive for clarity.

I hope you and your students enjoy rehearsing and performing **Firebolt**.
