PROGRAM NOTE

The composer writes, "The Amalfi Coast is an incredible destination full of culture and beauty. The coast is home to many Italian towns and villages all with a distinct character. My favorite of these towns is Ravello which has historically attracted artists, musicians and writers. Sitting on a hillside, almost 1,150 feet above sea level, the moon is ever-present on any summer evening. On a recent visit, I strolled through moonlit streets. I happily got lost in the nighttime listening to the soft, ambient sounds of relaxed conversation, live music and clinking dinnerware. The gorgeous views of the moon were both an incredible sight and distraction all at the same time. This selection aims to capture the artistic and quirky flair of the setting, with "la luna" acting as the central character."

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The portamenti are included to add both a challenge and flair. Ensure players make the initial note audible so the melodic note is clearly communicated before sliding.

The fluctuation in tempo can be interpreted freely and can be used to add whimsy to the general mood of the piece.

Stretching and pulling the accelerando and molto rallentando are encouraged if done cohesively.

Also, suggest that your musicians emphasize the desired articulations to a point of exaggeration.

The selection should be approached in a lighthearted fashion and students (and directors) are encouraged to have fun with it!
