### NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

- 1) A good portion of this chart features the drummer. Those (Solo/ Fill) bars should be flashy and fun but it is important that the drummer maintains a good sense of pulse and the rock beat. At the 132 metronome marking, feel free to "open up" for a longer solo. *Sidebar: The piece gets its title in part because any chart with a drum solo in it really has: "No Chance Of Losing". (Full disclosure....I'm a drummer! )*
- 2) The melody is fairly simple and straight forward. What gives the piece intrigue is the energy. The energy comes from emphasizing the articulations: The short notes short, and the long notes long with all of the accents in the right place.
- 3) The Piano part has chord symbols but it is best to play as written to avoid voicing clashes with the horn figures.
- 4) Be sure to insist that your students play the dynamic markings properly which will give life and expression to this composition.
- 5) Learning time is always hastened when students can hear the recorded example which can be downloaded from the Smart Chart website or played from the Barnhouse Interactive CD or website. (mp3's)
- 6) Most importantly, have fun with it !!
