NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

- 1) The Flügelhorn soloist should be miked and stand in front of the band or near the rhythm section.
- 2) The syncopated rhythms can seem repetitive if the articulations aren't emphasized. These rhythms set up the "feel." Make sure those are tight across the horns and saxes so that everything lines up with the rhythm section.
- 3) The Piano part has chord symbols but it is best to play as written to avoid voicing clashes with the horn figures.
- 4) The guitar is free to comp ad lib where indicated or use the suggested rhythms. Be careful to not get "too busy" - this goes for the drums, too.
- 5) Be sure to insist that your students play the dynamic markings properly which will give life and expression to this arrangement.
- 6) Learning time is always hastened when students can hear the recorded example which can be downloaded from the Smart Chart website or played from the Barnhouse Interactive CD or website. (mp3's)
- 7) Most importantly, have fun with it!!
