NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

- 1) This arrangement should be played with a Latin Jazz Feel in 2/2 - somewhat like a brisk Samba. The drummer should keep a steady, driving bass drum pattern that locks up with the bass.
- 2) The Solo section at Letter E is written for Alto Sax followed by Trumpet. The solo parts have chord changes and should be played ad. lib. if possible. This section may also be opened up for more solos if you wish.
- 3) Insist that your students play the dynamic markings and all articulations properly which will give life and expression to this arrangement.
- 4) The Piano part should be played as written in order to match the ensemble rhythms. There are chord symbols for improvised comping during the solo section but the pianist should be careful to provide space for the horn backgrounds and the soloist.
- 5) Learning time is always hastened when students can hear the recorded example which can be downloaded from the Smart Chart website or played from the Barnhouse website.
