NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

- 1) "Eleventh Hour" is a fun song for rhythm section players. Be sure the tempo is between 132-138 bpm to get the best overall feel for the song. The guitarist and pianist shouldn't play much busier than the written part. This will ensure the proper feel of the piece. The sax and brass phrases should be energetic and confident.
- 2) It is important that the drummer play a "shuffle feel" and not a typical swing beat. A ride cymbal should be used for the entire piece.
- 3) Insist that your students play the dynamic markings and all articulations properly which will give life and expression to this arrangement.
- 4) The solo section is written for Tenor Sax followed by Guitar. It may be "Open" for more solos if you wish.
- 5) The Piano part should be played as written in order to match the ensemble rhythms. There are chord symbols for improvised comping during the solo section but the pianist should be careful to provide space for the horn backgrounds and the soloist.
- 6) Learning time is always hastened when students can hear the recorded example which can be downloaded from the Smart Chart website or played from the Barnhouse website.
