#### ABOUT SKY BOUND

Imagine soaring...twisting and turning as you plunge through clouds into the bright azure blue...*Sky Bound!* Capture the feeling and exhilaration of flight, and imagine what it would sound like in the music you make! Encourage students to close their eyes, unleash their imaginations and re-create those visual images into sound! With a high energy, captivating opening *Sky Bound* is great way to start your concert!

#### **NOTES**


The piece opens with a powerful high brass statement expressing the anticipation and excitement of flying through a bright clear sky.

- Make certain that the descending horn line in M. 2 comes through and balances with the Trumpets
- The woodwinds entrance at M. 8 portrays the smoothness of gliding through air.
- The Clarinets in M. 16 have us dipping into clouds flying softer and smoother.
- Care should be given at M. 19 making certain the Ride Cymbal on dome and the Tambourine both balance with the Flutes.
- In M. 22 the Timpani roll should add to the texture, but not get lost.
- The Bells in M. 23 should come out!
- Carefully pace the crescendo in M. 29 all the way to M. 32 before fading into the Trumpet entrance in M. 32.
- Woodwind, Snare Drum and Tom accents should not be over done, but given just a little more weight to offset the Trumpet legato melody in M. 35.
- The accented notes in M. 47 lead us back into the main theme and catapult us out of the clouds into the bright clear blue sky!
- Accentuate the drama of the ending by paying special attention to the dynamics in M. 57 and the subito *p* in M. 60. Your band will crescendo into one more burst of energy as they soar to the end... *Sky Bound!*
