#### **About the Work**

This Negro Spiritual, as with most, is based on biblical text that illustrates a spiritual teaching and instructions to flee from the bonds of slavery. In the first canonized Gospel, Matthew recounts a parable of ten virgins in preparation for the Bridegroom. Matthew parallels the readiness of the wise virgins to the believing Israelites, and the foolish virgins to the unbelieving Israelites. Matthew's purpose is to provoke a sense of perpetual preparation amongst the believing Jews. He presents a clear and concise Gospel in order to lead unbelieving Israel into making an intelligent commitment to Christ.

The word "trimmed" in the original language of the New Testament is defined as *prepared or made ready*. This is the indicative mood of the text, and suggests that the Apostle Matthew is affirming the factuality of the scripture. Although all of the virgins fell asleep, the wise virgins were indeed prepared for the Bridegroom (Christ) with their lamps trimmed.

It is imperative that the ensemble feel the natural pulse on beats one and three. The singers should sing on the breath with intensity on the vowel, and sing with direction through the phrase. All accent and dynamic markings are important. Although the voice-leading is relatively simple, some chords may present a nice challenge to your ensembles' aural skills. This setting should not be restricted to church walls, but rather respected as a sacred art form for all venues and audiences.
