This excellent study on the legato (smooth and connected) reminds the student that when crossing strings within a slur, the notes on each string must be securely "stopped" in order to achieve a smooth and clean crossing.



Use a legato stroke near the middle of the bow and exaggerate the dynamics to create a "conversation" between the loud and soft voices.
