

## Rhythm in Music







1. Music is written on lines and spaces called a staff.



A staff has **five** lines and **four** spaces.



Notes are written on lines, or in spaces.



3. Piano music uses two clefs.

This is a **treble clef**, or **G clef** sign:




This is a bass clef, or F clef sign:



4. High tones are written on a treble staff.



Low tones are written on a bass staff.






