## About the Composer



Johann Sebastian Bach (1685–1750) was born into a large family of musicians. From a young age, members of his family taught him violin, harpsichord, organ, and composition. His love of the keyboard stemmed from this early exposure, and after completing a degree in music at a prestigious school, he took a post as a court musician and later court organist in Weimar, Germany. There, he gained a reputation as a talented organist and as a composer of organ preludes and other works for keyboard. His later compositions also included solo violin and orchestral works, such as the famous Brandenburg Concertos. From age 38, he was the director of music for the churches in Leipzig, Germany, where he composed religious works for choir.

## About the Arranger



**William Himes** was born and raised in Michigan, where he graduated from Port Huron High School and earned his Bachelor and Master of Music degrees from the University of Michigan. There he studied composition with Leslie Bassett and George Balch Wilson. He taught instrumental music for five years in the public schools of Flint, Michigan, and was also an adjunct lecturer in low brass at the University of Michigan-Flint.

Well known for his compositions and arrangements, Mr. Himes has more than 200 instrumental and choral publications to his credit. He is a member of the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP) and his music is frequently featured on international broadcasts and recordings.

From 1977 to 2015 Mr. Himes was head of The Salvation Army's Music and Gospel Arts Department for USA Central Territory in Chicago, Illinois. In this capacity also conducted the Chicago Staff Band, a 36-piece brass and percussion ensemble, which has been featured in numerous recordings and concert tours throughout the world.

Mr. Himes continues to be in demand as conductor, composer, lecturer and clinician. He has appeared throughout the United States, Argentina, Australia, Bermuda, Brazil, Canada, Denmark, France, Germany, Haiti, Jamaica, Japan, New Zealand, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom.

## About the Composition

*Fugue in G Minor*, BWV 578, popularly known as the “Little Fugue,” is a piece of music originally written for organ in approximately 1707 by Johann Sebastian Bach, a German composer who lived 1685–1750. It is called the “Little Fugue” to distinguish it from another fugue in G minor that Bach wrote around 1720 which is much longer and more challenging to play.

A *fugue* is a composition based on *counterpoint*, that is, multiple melodies sounding at the same time. The primary melody is presented alone, then other entries imitate that melody in different keys and sometimes different rhythms.

When arranging Bach’s organ piece for the modern concert band, I doubled voicings between brass and woodwinds while using the percussion section to add momentum and make Bach sound a little more contemporary for young musicians.

## Making an Audio or Video Recording

A license is required any time you make an audio or video recording of a copyrighted work. Audio recordings are compulsory, meaning we can't deny your request; you just need to apply for the Mechanical License and pay the royalty. The royalty rate is set by the Library of Congress. For current rates, please visit [www.copyright.gov](http://www.copyright.gov).

The license to make a video of a performance, known as a Synchronization License, is not compulsory. Permission must be obtained from the copyright holder before distributing any copies, regardless if they are being sold or given away for free.

## Arranging for Marching Band or Another Ensemble

We're pleased to grant licenses to make a marching band (or other) arrangement of one of our concert works. However, permission is required before work can begin, and there are a few works whose composers have indicated that they do not want their compositions to be altered. Please contact us to make sure the piece you're interested in is available for licensing.

If you're planning to play the original piece without **any** alterations or additions, then a license isn't needed. However, for example, if you're rewriting the brass parts for marching instruments (mellophones, bugles), or adding marching percussion, or making cuts, adding repeats, or creating a medley with another composition, a license is required.
