## THE COMPOSER

**Dean Sorenson** is Associate Professor and Director of Jazz Studies at the University of Minnesota, as well as a prolific and highly sought-after composer, arranger, trombonist, educator, and clinician. He is frequently featured at festivals and conventions around the United States and abroad. He also maintains a full schedule of concert and recording dates as a Yamaha performing artist.

Dean's latest recording project is *Colors of the Soul*, a CD of original music for jazz sextet. His most recent books include the *Excellence in Jazz Pedagogy* series and *First Place for Jazz*, a new and innovative method for beginning jazz players. He is the co-author of the *Standard of Excellence Jazz Ensemble Method* and *Advanced Jazz Ensemble Method*, a groundbreaking comprehensive series for middle school and high school jazz ensembles. He is also the author of *Jazz Combo Session* and *First Jazz Performance*—both under the *Standard of Excellence* banner.

Mr. Sorenson has composed and arranged for numerous prominent ensembles, including the Glenn Miller Orchestra, the Airmen of Note, and the Minnesota Orchestra. He is active as a commissioned composer and arranger for jazz ensemble, symphony orchestra, concert band, and chamber ensembles, and has also written several sacred choral pieces. ## THE COMPOSITION

Just northeast of Duluth, Minnesota, Castle Danger is a location steeped in mystery—a place of endless adventure. *The Blues at Castle Danger* is a straight-ahead swinging minor blues that captures that intrigue; perform the music with a sense of wonder and excitement fitting of this magical place.

Listen carefully for matching releases, beginning with the initial melodic statement at bar 5. Bar 28 brings a “rhythm out” section. Avoid conducting here unless it is absolutely necessary. Instead, have the horns listen to the hi-hat for time and tempo.

An open solo section begins at bar 41. The last time through, exaggerate the crescendo in bars 53–54 into the fortissimo shout chorus at bar 55. Strive for good balance up and down the ensemble. Be sure there is a noticeable dynamic difference during the tag ending in bars 75 to the end.

When playing swing, the drummer should play the kick drum very lightly and emphasize beats 2 and 4 on the hi-hat. Guitar and piano should trade off comping during the solos but can play at the same time during the rest of the chart.

## IMPROVISING SOLOS ON THE BLUES AT CASTLE DANGER

All FlexJazz series tunes allow players to improvise using a single scale. The solo section for *The Blues at Castle Danger* is found in bars 41–54. Students can improvise a solo using only the notes of the concert D blues scale. Any instrument can solo, and the solo section can be repeated as many times as necessary. Backgrounds can be cued at any time. For soloists who wish not to improvise, there is a suggested solo provided in all of the parts. The horn figures in bar 41 are only played the first time through the solo section.
