## THE COMPOSER

**Dean Sorenson** is Associate Professor and Director of Jazz Studies at the University of Minnesota, as well as a prolific and highly sought-after composer, arranger, trombonist, educator, and clinician. Mr. Sorenson is the author of *Total Jazz Theory*, as well *First Place for Jazz*, a new and innovative method for beginning jazz players. He is also the author of *Excellence in Jazz Pedagogy*, a series of instructional texts covering focused topics in jazz teaching. All are published by the Neil A. Kjos Music Company. His latest recording is *Colors of the Soul*, the debut release of the Dean Sorenson Sextet.

## THE COMPOSITION

*Funky Stew* features a simple, yet driving groove in the rhythm section. Make certain that all of the rhythm section players are listening carefully to one another, locking in their parts together. This is especially important on the “& of four” in bars 5, 7, 9, etc. The anticipation of the downbeat helps drive the forward motion of this groove.

The melody is played by everyone beginning at bar 9 and is passed around the different parts at bar 17. The rhythm section groove changes slightly at bar 25. Play close attention to the bass and the kick drum here to make sure this subtle change is made. The pyramid in bars 39–40, before the solos, is also used for intro and ending material. All entrances should be attacked cleanly with accents.

Beginning at bar 51 there is a section that features drums “trading” with the ensemble. There are suggested rhythms for the drummer to play but always encourage the player to improvise. The most important job for the drummer here is to keep the time steady and clear during the drum solos. Oftentimes simpler is better!

## IMPROVISING SOLOS ON FUNKY STEW

All **FlexJazz** series tunes allow players to improvise using a single scale. The solo section for *Funky Stew* is found in bars 41–50. Students can improvise a solo using only the notes of the concert B $\flat$  Blues scale. Any instrument can solo, and the solo section can be repeated as many times as necessary. Backgrounds can be cued at any time. For soloists who wish not to improvise, there is a suggested solo provided in all of the parts.
