## Program Notes:

Up, Up, and Away! was a labor of love for my sixth grade band several years ago in Granite Falls, Washington. I needed something students could play to build dexterity and endurance within their first five or six notes and the result was the A section of the piece. (The students at the time named the melody "Crazy Fingers: A Simple Symphony"). I revisited this tune in the spring of 2022 and it morphed into "Up, Up, and Away!". This piece is an opportunity for young musicians to develop finger dexterity, breath control, and endurance while exploring contrasting styles in a simple triple meter. I hope this piece sparks joy and a sense of adventure!

Erin Keeton-Howard is a Seattle-based music educator, musician, and composer. She holds a B.S. in Music Education from the University of Missouri and holds a M.A. in Music Education with an emphasis in Conducting from the University of Washington.
