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# The Kraken

By Kevin Sluder, Grade 3

## **Program Notes:**

A frightening tale for all who sail across the sea, the Kraken is storied to be a massive squid that lurks in the deep waters of the ocean.

Our adventure opens with a churning sea. Waves become more violent as the sky grows darker. Suddenly, giant tentacles reach out through the tumultuous waters...the Kraken appears! Tentacles swat at the ship, sliding along the hull as they try to grip the boat. Sailors fight the hurricane winds to turn the ship away from the grips of the Kraken. The boat is finally free, but only momentarily. The Kraken has followed! Sailors race to grab harpoons, long spears meant to protect the ship from the creatures that lie below. As the harpoons fly, the Kraken finally retreats, leaving the ship safe to find dry land. The creature slinks below the waters, waiting for the next ship to sail in its path.

## **Notes to the Conductor:**

Spend time early on breaking down the 8th note syncopations and the necessary subdivision internalization. Suggested shifting fingerings are provided, and while the bass can spend most of the piece in  $\frac{1}{2}$  position, more advanced options are encouraged. Work with students to take dynamics and accents to the extreme, imitating the sound of the waves crashing against the ship. The glissandos should be deliberate and dramatic. The doubles (slashes) are optional, but are highly-encouraged. For m. 91 to the end, remind the students that oftentimes divisi will lose some of the power than comes with purely unison parts. Teach them to raise their individual dynamic level when it splits to help keep the group from losing impact right near the end. Feel free to teach the kids how an F# sometimes plays a colorful role in the key of D minor. A Picardy third slowly invades this exciting conclusion!

Most importantly, enjoy telling this tale with your students!
