## About the Composition

*American Emblem* is a work for concert band that characterizes the American spirit. After its majestic and fanfare-like introduction initiated by the percussion, the piece moves into a bright Allegro section that features a trumpet solo followed by a trumpet duet. After just a hint of *Yankee Doodle*, the horns announce the beginning of the slower middle section, which begins as a woodwind chorale. This stately theme then modulates from B♭ major to E♭ major, adding the brass with the theme and interesting obbligato lines in the upper woodwinds. As this section concludes, it moves once again into the opening majestic theme, marked by the percussion, and returns to B♭ major. The piece finishes with a spirited Allegro, drawing upon fragments of themes found throughout the piece.

*American Emblem* demands the attention of both performer and listener alike. Its many musical styles and interesting examples of orchestration make it the perfect piece for concert and festival use.

## About the Composer

Bill Calhoun received his Master of Music degree from Mansfield State University (PA) and his Bachelor of Music Education and Applied Music degree from Ithaca College (NY). Having been a public school music educator for over 30 years, he was most recently Director of Bands and Department Chair at DeWitt Middle School in the Ithaca City School District where he was also the district-wide Curriculum Chair for Instrumental Music. Bill retired from public school teaching July 1, 2010.

Currently a member of BMI and NAfME (formerly MENC), Bill has written countless band, brass and percussion arrangements/compositions for groups both concert and marching throughout the United States, Japan, Canada and England. He has music for string orchestra as well as concert band published with Carl Fischer Music, and has also published with Warner Bros. Publications and Ethos Publications. His music has been performed at the Midwest Clinic in Chicago, Illinois and numerous All-County festivals. The Osaka Municipal Symphonic Band of Osaka, Japan also featured one of his pieces on a CD of contemporary wind band music.
