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About the Composition

Most people that I encounter do not enjoy the cold of winter. Some think of shoveling snow, others think of freezing toes and runny noses! I personally love the winter, and oftentimes I find myself sitting outside by the lake watching the trees as they transition from beautiful colors and fall to the ground. *The Last to Fall* to me is a celebration of that transition, as the last leaves fall winter arrives. Winter may be the time when things die but you can also look at it as the time right before new things arrive.

This piece revolves around an ascending and descending eighth note pattern. This motif travels around the ensemble generously and should be brought out of the texture whenever it is present. The piece builds on this idea and gradually progresses in volume until a slight style change at m. 37 where the pattern transitions into more of a “falling effect”. In this section both ascending and descending eighth note patterns should get the same “weight”. Most ensembles play very reserved at the high point in a piece of music but care should be taken at m. 66 (climax). It is intended to be somewhat aggressive and abrasive as the F. Horn cuts through the *fp*.

About the Composer

Tyler Arcari (b. 1989) is an emerging composer of music for bands and orchestras. He received his Bachelors and Master’s Degrees from Troy University where he studied with famed composer Ralph Ford, Robert Grice and David Samuel. During his tenure at Troy University, Mr. Arcari wrote music for various ensembles on campus as well as music for District Honor Bands and the Alabama All-State Festival. Besides his responsibilities as a composer, Tyler has taught Orchestration and Arranging at the collegiate level, high school music and middle school music. He currently serves as the Band Director at Russell County High School in Seale, AL.
