About the Composition

Virgo is a lush and dramatic piece that is intended to reflect upon lost loved ones. In the case of the composer, it is a remembrance of his late brother, Scott Andrew Sweet. The title of the piece refers to the astrological sign of the composer's brother, who was born on September 19, 1970. *Virgo* is dedicated to his memory. The piece utilizes many close-knit intervals and dissonances and care should be taken throughout the work to insure that these intervals blend evenly into a singular sonority. The piece begins with an introduction that utilizes portions of the A theme which is presented in full at measure 10 by the clarinets. The theme is repeated at m. 18 and moves to a brief B section at m. 26. The B section utilizes inverted "pyramid" chords and each voice should enter with a slight accent so that the rhythmic structure of the pyramid is audible. The A and B sections are both repeated with slight variation and are followed by a C section at m. 58. This section utilizes melodic counterpoint between all voices and care must be taken to maintain a strong individual presence from voice to voice. These voices lead to a dramatic arrival on beat 3 of m. 68. From this point, the C section decreases in intensity, coming to rest at m. 82. The introductory material returns at m. 84 with melodic percussion accompaniment and leads to a final statement of both A and B themes in a more developed and intense fashion. A delicate and restrained coda appears at m. 113 and brings the piece to a close.

About the Composer

George Sweet was born in York County, South Carolina, in 1979. He received Master's Degrees in Composition and Instrumental Conducting from Northern Arizona University and a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from Mars Hill University. George's music is regularly performed worldwide and has been heard at numerous state and regional Honor Band and Orchestra Festivals, Disney's Magic Music Days, Bands of America, the College Band Directors National Association Conference, the Concurso de Musica Festival in Peru, the Melbourne School Band and Strings Festival in Australia, the National Orchestra Festival, and the Midwest Clinic. His various commissions include those from professional performers, public schools, university ensembles, and also a video game under a grant from the Hewlett Foundation. George has taught Theory, Band, Chorus, and Orchestra at both public school and university levels. He is a member of ASCAP and is the recipient of multiple ASCAP awards for concert music. George has also received awards from the American Prize, the Music Teachers National Association, and numerous "call for scores" competitions from various professional ensembles. George is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, MENC, and is an honorary member of Kappa Kappa Psi. His music regularly receives positive reviews in both the Instrumentalist magazine and the Journal of the American String Teachers Association and is included in the Smart Music interactive program.
