About the Composition

Radetzky March is one of the most famous compositions of the waltz king Johann Strauss. It has served as the encore piece for the New Year's concert of the Vienna Philharmonic for over 100 years. There is even a tradition kept alive by audience members of clapping softly along with the march on the first iteration of the melody, followed by thunderous clapping on the second. For the first time, this arrangement has been made to make this wonderful march accessible to all bands through its flexible scoring.

The march should be in a more regal European style at a tempo of 100 beats per minute, not at the faster American-style march tempo of 120. The grace notes of the first strain are important, and special care should be given to making them sparkle. The terrace dynamics should be carefully observed. The theme at m. 25 should have a contrasting lilt from the more bombast secondary theme.

The Trio of the march has the common modulation to the subdominant with a strong introduction followed by a return of a more lifting theme. Again, great contrast should be made between the soft and loud sections of the Trio. There is then a *Da Capo al Fine* back to the original key and themes to complete the work. This is a timeless march with a different march style than that of the usual American-style marches students are used to. It will be a great teaching tool for them to learn this important march and its style.

It has been my pleasure to have the opportunity to write this piece. I hope you and your students enjoy it and find it useful for your program.

However, his main focus is on selecting, editing and producing concert band and string orchestra music for the company. He travels the world representing Carl Fischer Music doing clinic/workshops and guest conducting appearances. His background as a former middle school and university band director at Syracuse University, combined with his composing and editing, have placed Larry at the forefront of music for school ensembles. He holds a Bachelors Degree in Music Education from Florida State University and Masters Degrees in Conducting and Composition from James Madison University in Virginia.
