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Notes to the Conductor

This adaptation of *Christmas Carol Trilogy* was arranged to accompany the choral arrangement of the same title by Russell Robinson. It can be played with Robinson's vocal arrangements with band and chorus together or as a stand-alone piece for band. If performed together with a chorus, it is recommended that the performers play one to two dynamic levels lower than written (depending on the size of the chorus) so as not to overpower the singers. Please see the chart below for further explanation.

Written Dynamic (To be used if band alone)	Large Chorus (1 dynamic lower)	Small Chorus (2 dynamics lower)
<i>mf</i>	<i>mp</i>	<i>p</i>

Another possibility for performance is for a small group of wind instruments with chorus. Here, performers would play the written dynamics. Below are a few recommended chamber ensembles that would work with a variety of choruses, though there are several other alternatives. In any case, the conductor should be careful to choose a set of instruments that is both balanced in register (soprano, alto, tenor, bass) and in role (melody, countermelody, bass line, etc.)

- **Option 1 (Woodwind Sextet)** Flute (Oboe), Clarinet 1, Clarinet 2, Alto Saxophone, Tenor Saxophone (Bassoon), Baritone Saxophone (Bass Clarinet)
- **Option 2 (Brass Quintet)** Trumpet 1, Trumpet 2, Horn, Trombone (Baritone), Tuba (Baritone Saxophone)
- A final option is to perform with one player per instrumental part. In all instances, the conductor should pay close attention to the balance of the percussion instruments.

About the Arranger

Before his appointment at Joe E. Newsome High School, Mr. Miller was Assistant Director of Bands at Robert Vela High School in Edinburg, TX under Bob Barfield, and the Director of Bands at Weeki Wachee High School. While at WWHS, Miller was awarded the School Board of Hernando County's "Hernando H.E.R.O.E.S." Award (Hernando Educators Reaching Out to Every Student), and was also given the Superintendent's "Excellence" Award for his services to the community. In 2016 Mr. Miller received the National Band Association's Certificate of Merit for Marching Excellence for outstanding contributions to marching bands.

Mr. Miller holds a Master of Music degree in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Florida and a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Syracuse University. As a graduate teaching assistant for the University of Florida bands under Dr. David Waybright, Mr. Miller guest conducted the Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band, and Concert Band, taught undergraduate conducting lessons, and was a staff member and music designer for Florida's Gator Marching Band.

Mr. Miller is a published composer and arranger with Alfred Music, Carl Fischer Music, the F.J.H. Music Company Inc., and Eighth Note Publications. His Tribute for Band was named one of 2017's best 100 new works for band by the Western International Band Clinic, and received J.W. Pepper & Son, Inc.'s editors choice. Mr. Miller serves as a music and drill designer for high school and college marching bands across the United States. His music was performed during halftime at Superbowl XLVIII, the National Trumpet Competition, the International Trombone Festival, as well as numerous B.C.S. Bowl games.

Mr. Miller was a conducting drum major and trumpeter for the Boston Crusaders Drum and Bugle Corps under Howard Weinstein, played mellophone for the Syracuse Brigadiers Drum and Bugle Corps, and was a visual technician for the Blue Stars Drum and Bugle Corps.

Mr. Miller is a member of the Music Educators National Conference, the Florida Music Educators Association, the Florida Bandmasters Association, the National Band Association and is a brother of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He currently resides in Riverview, FL and is happily married to his wife, Vivian. When he isn't in the classroom, Mr. Miller enjoys traveling the world and experiencing the food culture wherever he goes.
