Notes

Magnolia was composed during the summer of 2010. It is intended to combine rudimental drumming vocabulary with the structure and flexibility of a concert solo. All rolls should be performed "open," as rhythmic doublings of an underlying check pattern.

A few different types of articulation styles are used in the notation. To best communicate the nuance of the music, these articulations are approached in the following manner.



Other aspects of the piece, such as drag interpretation and stickings, are left to the discretion of the performer.
