PROGRAM NOTES

Close Your Eyes and Dream is a lullaby dedicated to my children. The twins came a little early and had to spend some time in NICU, so we were there every day holding them while they slept and singing to them. I had composed a melody earlier, and it was during this time that I wrote the lyrics that would become *Close Your Eyes and Dream*. The variation between the verses reflects the babies' unique personalities which were apparent from the very beginning.

*Hush now, my baby, and please go to sleep.
Your mother and I are here with you.*

*Oh, it's ok, my baby.
Rest your head on me.
I will hold you close and sing so sweetly.
It's ok, go to sleep.*

*Oh, It's ok, my baby.
Close your eyes and dream.
I can see your eyelids getting heavy.
It's ok, go to sleep.
Go to sleep, go to sleep, go to sleep...*

After a peaceful introduction, two melodies are introduced. Set in strophic form, they are first presented with a simple, music box accompaniment and then with a more elaborate treatment. Eventually everything fades away as the baby (hopefully) drifts off to sleep.

PERFORMANCE NOTES

The percussion parts for *Close Your Eyes and Dream* may be performed in three ways:

- As an octet featuring all of the percussion parts
- Smaller ensembles may omit the Percussion 1 and 2 parts and perform with as few as six players.
- Larger ensembles may expand the instrumentation by doubling the marimba, vibraphone, and xylophone parts.

In each of these configurations you may add the optional vocal part performed by a soloist or a group of voices.

Percussion 1 should use double-sided sticks to allow for a quick transition from felt ends to wooden tips before letter G. Percussion 2 should clip the triangle on a stand to free up a hand for the mark tree.

PLAYERS AND INSTRUMENTATION

Close Your Eyes and Dream requires **6-8+ players** with the following instrumentation:


- 1 glockenspiel
- chimes
- 1 xylophone
- 1 vibraphone (optional doubling)
- 1 marimba (low A, shared)
- timpano (29")
- 1 triangle

Optional instruments*

- 1 suspended cymbal
- 1 sizzle cymbal
- 1 mark tree
- 1 extra triangle
- sleigh bells
- vocals (soloist or group)
- extra mallet keyboard instruments (for doubling)
