He signed a free agent contract with the N.F.L.'s Atlanta Falcons in 1988. Following his football career, he went on to complete his MS degree in Music Education from the University of Illinois. He has also completed additional graduate work at the University of North Texas and the University of Kansas.

Mr. Foster has been a band director and has taught at the University of Maryland, Texas Christian University, Haskell Indian Nations University, and Tennessee Tech University. Additionally, he has taught for many years in the Eudora and DeSoto, Kansas middle schools and high schools. He is a highly successful composer and arranger of band music at all levels, including works for military bands and marching bands.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- The upper number indicates that there are 4 beats to a measure. The lower number indicates that a 1/4 note receives one beat.

DYNAMIC MARKINGS

p (piano) - soft

mp (mezzo piano) – moderately soft

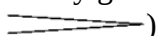
mf (mezzo forte) – moderately loud

f (forte) – loud

ff (fortissimo) – very loud

fp (forte piano) – start the note loud, then instantly play soft

crescendo () – gradually get louder

diminuendo, or decrescendo () – gradually get softer

STYLE INDICATORS

accent (>) – emphasis on a note or chord. Accented notes are separated

sfz (sforzando) – a sudden strong accent

staccato (·) – detached, separated, and light

tenuto (-) – hold the note for its full value

bell tones – start the note with a heavy accent, then get softer like a ringing bell

OTHER TERMS

fermata () – sustain or hold the note as long as the conductor indicates

molto rall. (molto rallentando) – Molto = very; Rallentando = becoming gradually slower

Presto – a fast tempo marking

rit. (ritardando) – gradually get slow
