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## PROGRAM NOTES

It offers young bands the opportunity to explore new challenges while giving them some wonderful material for their winter concert. *In Regal Wonder* was written and dedicated to the El Capitan Middle School Advanced Band (Fresno, California) and their young conductor, Mr. Christopher Golden.

## ABOUT THE COMPOSER

Gary P. Gilroy is a Professor of Music and Director of Bands at California State University, Fresno. In 1993 he was appointed Associate Director of Bands and Director of the Bulldog Marching Band. After 13 years in this position and building one of the finest collegiate marching bands on the west coast, Dr. Gilroy became Director of Bands in 2006. Prior to this appointment he served for a decade as Director of Bands at Fred C. Beyer High School in Modesto, California where his band was awarded several national honors as well as the International Sudler Shield Award from the John Philip Sousa Foundation. Gilroy also served as faculty at CSU, Stanislaus and graduate assistant at the University of Oregon in Eugene, Oregon where he completed his doctorate in 1995.

Dr. Gilroy and his wife Dena have lived in Clovis, California since 1993. His daughter, Alexandra, has music degrees from UCLA and UNLV and is currently a music teacher in the Clovis Unified School District and his son, Nicholas, is a graduate of CSU, Long Beach and a freelance percussionist in the Los Angeles area.

#### LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Good balance between the melody and the other voices requires that everyone learn to listen carefully, and to adjust their volume so that it compliments the total sound.

$\frac{2}{4}$  - The upper number indicates that there are 2 beats to a measure. The lower number indicates that a quarter note receives one beat.


#### DYNAMIC MARKINGS

*p* (piano) – soft

*mp* (mezzo piano) – moderately soft

*mf* (mezzo forte) – moderately loud

*f* (forte) – loud

crescendo (  ) – gradually get louder

diminuendo, or decrescendo (  ) – gradually get softer

#### STYLE INDICATORS

accent (  ) – emphasis on a note or chord. Accented notes are separated

staccato (  ) – detached, separated, and light

tenuto ( - ) – hold the note for its full value

#### OTHER TERMS

slur – a curved line that indicates that the notes under it should be played connected

tie – a curve line that joins two or more notes
