## Program Notes

George Frideric Handel (1685–1759) was an important Baroque composer known for his many operas as well as instrumental pieces. Handel's opera *Scipione* (HWV 20) features the famous Roman general Scipio Africanus as the main character. Scipio (236–183 BC) was a skilled Roman general who never lost a battle and is considered one of the greatest commanders in history. This simple yet regal-sounding processional march is not only from Handel's opera but is also the regimental march of the British Grenadier Guards. This confidence-building arrangement for developing orchestra stays in first position, doubling violin 2 and viola, and giving all sections important melodic and harmonic parts.

## About the Arranger

Christina Hans received her B.A. in Music Education, magna cum laude, from Old Dominion University and her Master's Degree in Music from the University of Connecticut. She has been teaching music in Virginia since 1997 and has been the Orchestra Director at Hugo A. Owens Middle School in Chesapeake, Virginia since 1999. Under her direction the Hugo Owens Orchestra program has doubled in size and was recently selected to perform at the Virginia Music Educators Association Conference. Christina was awarded "Teacher of the Year" at Hugo A. Owens Middle School for 2011-2012 and was a nominee for Virginia's ASTA "Orchestra Director of the Year." Mrs. Hans plays clarinet with the Virginia Wind Symphony and has had the honor to perform twice with the group at the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Clinic. Her string orchestra arrangements have been selected as Editor's Choice by JW Pepper and have been performed at the Midwest Clinic. Mrs. Hans resides in Chesapeake, Virginia with her husband, Dr. Steven Hans and their two rescue dogs.
