## Program Notes

*Koa Warriors* is a piece based on the Hawaiian Koa warriors – elite fighters of the islands. Their name originated from the tree they would use to fashion their weapons, the Koa tree. The wood from this tree provided all their battle tools, which were vast and diverse, suitable for all types of battlefield combat. The piece is constructed using a rhythmic canon made up of only quarter and half notes. It might be helpful to clap out these rhythms and/or “shadow bow” the rhythms in order for the students to feel at ease with the moving lines, especially when there is a repeated bowing pattern (see m. 21 and mm. 32-35). The melody stays within the D major scale, and there is very little string crossing with a few exceptions in the lower strings. Encourage your students to follow the contour of the lines to create musicality and phrasing whenever possible. Optional taiko (or bass drum) and suspended cymbal parts were written with the student percussionist in mind and can add interest and create an even more fiery “tribal” experience. More advanced percussionists can feel free to embellish the percussion part by adding more moving notes or rolls. May *Koa Warriors* bring your students much enjoyment!

## About the Composer

Argentine-born composer and violinist Nicolas Repetto creates music for film, television, and multimedia while collaborating with talented and creative filmmakers from all over the world. His music can be heard on networks such as The Learning Channel, Univision, Amazon Prime, and at prestigious film festivals such as Sundance and Slamdance in Park City, Utah; Film Independent/Los Angeles Film Festival; HollyShorts Film Festival in Hollywood, California; and the Festival de Cannes in Cannes, France. As a violinist, Nicolas has performed with the Miami Symphony Orchestra, Alhambra Orchestra, and the New World Symphony. He has also played on soundtracks and provided violin and viola solos for many independent feature films, live shows, and records in studios around the Los Angeles area with the CMG Recording Orchestra. Nicolas is an alumnus of the esteemed ASCAP Film Scoring Workshop with Richard Bellis in 2016 and the recipient of the ASCAP Foundation Michelle and Dean Kay Award. Nicolas composes music for various ensembles as well as commissioned works. His symphonic and chamber works have been performed in the United States, Argentina, and Europe. As a string orchestra teacher and conductor, Nicolas led the superior-rated Ruth K. Broad Bay Harbor Symphonies and the SFYS Symphonies. Nicolas holds a B.M. in violin performance and music education from the University of Miami, and an M.M. with emphasis on composition and arranging from Florida State University.
