Dear parties,

This afternoon, the OOR received an e-mail from the Office of the Governor with two attachments: a privilege log and what appear to be *in camera* documents. The e-mail was addressed to myself, Mr. Bagwell, and Ms. Allen. From the text of the email, it appears that the attachments were intended to be a cover letter and a privilege log of the *in camera* documents, and not the *in camera* documents themselves. There is no indication within the e-mail that the Office of the Governor intended to release the *in camera* documents.

It appears that through an administrative oversight the wrong PDF file was attached to the e-mail resulting in the *in camera* documents being sent to all parties involved in the case. Believing this to be an unintentional administrative error, the OOR immediately instructed Mr. Bagwell to delete the e-mail. Craig Staudenmaier, counsel for Mr. Bagwell, also instructed Mr. Bagwell to delete the e-mail. Mr. Staudenmaier has informed the OOR that Mr. Bagwell has deleted the e-mail and attachments, along with a previous identical e-mail and attachments that were sent in error earlier today.

Please be advised that to comply with the OOR *in camera* process, *in camera* documents must be submitted via hard copy or CD-ROM in accordance with our Interim Guidelines.
