May 18th, 2017

On May 11, 2017, Governor Branstad signed Senate File 501 into law. It will be effective July 1, 2017. The new law is a modification of IA Code Section 331.655 and increases certain fees collected by county sheriff's statewide. All fees are the new standard for all Sheriff's Offices.
