DEFINITION—KEEP: to maintain in safety from injury, harm, or danger. (to guard as with a garrison)

Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Isaiah 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace...

DEFINITION—PEACE: safety (state); the state of being safe or free from danger; inner tranquility;

Mark 4:39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Acknowledge (3b)

A. The _____ of our Mind

Isaiah 26:3 Whose mind is stayed on thee: Because he trusteth in thee.

MIND — inclination (attitude)

DEFINITION—STAYED: to be made secure or firm; to be supported (*Passive and so supported by thee*)

B. The _____ of our Trust

Isaiah 26:3 Whose mind is stayed on thee: Because he trusteth in thee.

DEFINITION—TRUSTETH: to confide in any one, to set one's hope and confidence upon any one (Gesenius)

Psalms 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: His heart is fixed, trusting in the Lord.

A. Constant _____ (4a)

Isaiah 26:4 Trust ye in the Lord for ever...

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; And lean not unto thine own understanding 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, And he shall direct thy paths.

Isaiah 26:4 ...For in the Lord JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:
