Message Title: Helpers in Christ

Message Text: Acts 18:1-4

Introduction:

Paul left Athens to continue his second missionary tour. He left behind several believers who turned to Christ from the rampant idolatry of Athens. He journeyed on his own some fifty miles to Corinth, the capital city of Achaia. The wickedness of Corinth cannot be overstated. Yet Paul would spend eighteen months there faithfully laboring bi-vocationally to win the Corinthians to Jesus Christ. While in Corinth, God blessed Paul with two lifetime friends, who would become *helpers in Christ*, as well as reuniting him with Timotheus and Silas.

Acts 18:1 After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth;

NOTE: Timotheus and Silas had not yet arrived from Thessalonica.

Ecclesiastes 4:9–10 Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. 10 For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up.

Philippians 4:11 Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.

	NOTE: Corinth was 50 miles from Athens
	CORINTH WAS THE CAPITAL OF ACHAIA — the city itself stood on a little island; it had two ports, Lechæum on the west, and Cenchrea on the east and was known for its trade.
	CORINTH WAS — in nationality, language and religion.
	CORINTH WAS — full of luxury; very effeminate; focused on the arts (Corinthian brass, capitals, and pillars); boasting in

CORINTH WAS A WICKED — The very term "Corinthian" came to mean a profligate. "To Corinthianize" meant to practice whoredom. The worship of Venus boasted of 1,000 female slaves who were free to strangers. Paul's description of pagan vice, Romans 1:18–32, was written in Corinth. —Lenski

Acts 18:2 And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:)...

NOTE: Likely Aquila and Priscilla had found Christ in Jerusalem at Pentecost or as result of the believers who returned to Rome from Pentecost.

QUOTE: [Claudius] expelled the Jews from Rome, who were constantly exciting tumults under their leader, Chrestus. —Suetonius, a Roman historian (Life of Claudius, ch. 25)
