Title: Before Spiritual Influence

#### Introduction:

2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Colossians 2:6–7 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: 7 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

Our lives either influence others toward Christ or away from Christ. We desire to influence others toward Christ, yet too often try to do so in their own wisdom and strength. Jesus modeled ministry that flowed out of prayerfulness. Jesus told us that "...without me, ye can do nothing" Without Him we cannot discern the spiritual needs of others nor can we meet those spiritual needs influencing them toward Christ. Let's



learn from the pattern of Christ before He helped His disciples to take another spiritual step of growth.

QUOTE: Accusations harden the will. Questions stimulate the conscience.

Matthew 16:17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Bar-jona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.
