The nation of Israel was facing dark days as a consequence of the pride of their leaders and the sin of the people. On the heels of God's announcement of the their punishment, God delivers a message of hope and renewal for His people. This message is most certainly meaningful to us today.

Isaiah 40:31 But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings as eagles; They shall run, and not be weary; And they shall walk, and not faint.

DEFINITION—WAIT: to hope (in someone); to have trust or confidence in someone; especially as regards the future.

Psalm 25:3 Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: Let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.

Lamentations 3:25 The Lord is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.

1 Timothy 4:10 For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe.

DEFINITION—RENEW: to reestablish on a new, usually improved, basis or make new or like new; to put on afresh; to keep putting on fresh strength.
