PFL NOTES

- The 2024 Pioneer Football League season begins with 10 Week 1 scheduled contests. Morehead State opens the season with its 6 p.m. Thursday outing against Division II Central State (Ohio).
- Defending champion Drake also opens its season at home when it hosts Division II Quincy in Des Moines. Meanwhile, St. Thomas also opens up at home against Division II Sioux Falls.
- Those are three of the seven games in which a PFL team plays its home opener. Dayton, Butler, Stetson, and San Diego also play their home openers during Week 1.
- The PFL's coaches picked Drake to win the 2024 PFL title after winning the 2023 title, their seventh PFL championship and first since 2012. The Bulldogs received eight of the 11 first-place votes from the league's coaches. St. Thomas was second in the preseason poll, followed by Butler and San Diego.
- Drake defensive end Finn Claypool, the reigning PFL Defensive Player of the Year, was named to the Buck Buchanan Award Preseason Watch List presented by Stats Perform. He also was named to the Stats PerformPerform'sson All-America Team.
- Davidson running back Mari Adams and Drake quarterback Luke Bailey were named to the 35-player Walter Payton Watch Award Watch List, also presented by Stats Perform.
- For a third consecutive year, there are two new head coaches patrolling the sidelines in the league. Former Princeton assistant head coach Mike Willis takes over at Marist following Jim Parady's retirement after 32 seasons in Poughkeepsie. Morehead State turned to Fairmont State head coach Jason Woodman to lead its football program in 2024.
- The PFL had a team listed in the two FCS Preseason Polls. Drake received votes in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 poll. Meanwhile, Butler received votes in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll.
- The FCS already has a win against the FBS this season, with Montana State topping New Mexico in Week Zero action.
- The 2024 NCAA Division I Football Championship will see the top 16 teams seeded for the first time since the 2000 season. Previously, the committee only seeded the top eight teams.

DEFENDING PFL CHAMPION DRAKE PICKED TO REPEAT

Drake University, the defending Pioneer Football League champion, is picked to win the 2024 championship, as selected in the league's Preseason Coaches' Poll, released Tuesday and voted upon by the league's head coaches.

Drake received eight of the 11 first-place votes from the league's coaches and 98 of the maximum 100 points available, with coaches unable to vote for their own teams. St. Thomas, the 2022 PFL Champion, followed Drake in the poll with 87 points, including one first-place vote. Davidson also received a first-place vote and totaled 81 points to finish third in the poll. Butler (72 points) and San Diego (67) were picked to finish fourth and fifth, with San Diego receiving a first-place vote. The pair rounded out a group of teams that are the clear frontrunners entering the season.

PFL SEES FOUR 2023 MAJOR AWARD WINNERS RETURN FOR 2024

For a second consecutive season, four of the PFL's five major award winners from 2023 return for the 2024 season, led by Drake linebacker Finn Claypool, the reigning PFL Defensive Player of the Year. Teammate Shane Dunning, the reigning PFL Special Teams Player of the Year, joins him as a preseason honoree as a placekicker and punter. Stetson swept last season's freshmen honors, and both student-athletes return, with linebacker Andrew Martin earning a Preseason All-PFL and

WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE RETURNS ACROSS THE PFL

An incredible 119 student-athletes recognized on the 2023 All-PFL Teams and honorable mention lists return for the 2024 season, including 12 returning First Team All-PFL selections and 12 returning Second Team All-PFL honorees.

DRAKE'S CLAYPOOL A PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN AND NAMED TO BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

Drake junior linebacker Finn Claypool was one of 35 athletes named to the preseason watch list for the 2023 Buck Buchanan Award, presented by FedEx Ground and given annually to the National Defensive Player of the Year in Division I FCS college football. Claypool also was a Stats Performance Preseason All-American after becoming the second student-athlete in league history to follow up a Freshman Defensive Player of the Year campaign by winning the league's Defensive Player of the Year award the following year. Last season, he compiled a 55-tackle campaign that included 19.0 tackles for loss, 12.5 sacks, five forced fumbles, and two pass breakups.

BUTLER'S BUSHKA LANDS ON PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

The PFL saw two student-athletes – Davidson running back Mari Adams and Drake quarterback Luke Bailey – named to the 35-player preseason watch list for the 2024 Walter Payton Award, presented annually by Stats Perform to the national offensive player of the year in Division I FCS college football. As a sophomore, Adams led the PFL and finished fifth nationally with 15 rushing touchdowns while ranking among conference leaders in rushing yards (1,019), yards per rush (6.21), and yards per game (92.6). Bailey was named Second Team All-PFL and Academic All-PFL after starting all 12 games under center last season. He threw for 2,557 yards on 212 completions with 16 touchdowns while leading Drake to the 2024 PFL title.

VALPARAISO NAMES KEARSTIN SCHWEITZER RUNNING BACKS COACH, BECOMES FIRST FEMALE POSITION COACH IN PFL

Valparaiso announced the addition of Kearstin Schweitzer as the team's running backs coach on August 25. Schweitzer, who joins the Beacons after a stint working with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers of the National Football League, becomes the first female position coach in Valpo and Pioneer Football League history. She joins St. Thomas' Anna Caruso (Quality Control: In-Game Strategy and Data Research) as a female with on-field coaching responsibilities in the PFL.

MARIST & MOREHEAD STATE LED BY NEW HEAD COACHES

Marist and Morehead State each made changes at head coach before the 2024 season – the third consecutive season two league members have made changes at the top of their programs. Marist saw long-time head coach Jim Parady retire after a 32-year career with the Red Foxes. Mike Willis becomes the program's fifth head coach. He takes over in Poughkeepsie after serving as assistant head coach and offensive coordinator at Princeton the previous four seasons to cap a nine-year career with the Tigers. Morehead State hired Fairmont State head coach Jason Woodman as the program's 15th head coach. Woodman guided the Fighting Falcons to 60 wins and five winning seasons during his 11 seasons.

42 PFL STUDENT-ATHLETES NAMED TO 2024 NFF HAMPSHIRE HONOR SOCIETY

In April, the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) announced the 2024 NFF Hampshire Honor Society members, with 42 Pioneer Football League student-athletes among the 1,762 qualified for membership. Dayton (14) and Valparaiso (12) had double-digit student-athletes recognized on the Honor Society. St. Thomas (8), Marist (7), and Butler (1) also saw student-athletes recognized. Members of the NFF Hampshire Society are seniors or graduate college football players from all divisions of the NCAA, NAIA, and Spring Football who maintained a cumulative 3.2 GPA or better during their college careers.
