## PFL NOTES

- For a second straight week, 10 of the league's teams will be in action, with only Dayton taking Week 3 off. The slate features four games against ranked opponents with Davidson, San Diego, Morehead State, and Drake all on the road against Top 25 teams.
- With Presbyterian and San Diego's victories in Week 2, the PFL now has five wins against FCS opposition in 2025 with two weeks plus remaining in nonconference play. The five wins are the league's most since 2019 and a sixth win would be the league's most since 2009. The league record for most wins against FCS teams in a season since 2000 is 10 set during the 2001 season.
- Presbyterian's victory against nationally-ranked Mercer in Week 1 was the PFL's first win against a ranked FCS opponent since 2018, when Butler defeated Youngstown State to begin the season. San Diego's victory against Southern Utah in Week 1 was the league's second against a Top 25 FCS foe. It is the first time the league has two wins against nationally-ranked opponents in the same season.
- Four of the league's five new head coaches have recorded a win in their new home through two weeks. First, it was Drake's Joe Woodley and Valparaiso's Andy Waddle who picked up wins in their Week 1 debuts. Week 2 action saw Butler's Kevin Lynch and Stetson's Mike Jasper pick up their first victories.
- Following a vote by the NCAA Division I Board of Directors in June, St. Thomas has officially completed the reclassification process, making it an active member of NCAA Division I and eligible to compete in NCAA championships. The Tommies will compete for the PFL automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs for the first time this season.
- Davidson senior running back Mari Adams and Drake senior linebacker Sean Allison are the PFL's representatives on the 2025 Walter Payton and Buck Buchanan Award Preseason Watch Lists, respectively. Drake senior long snapper Brett Welsing joined Adams on the 2025 Stats Perform FCS Preseason All-America Teams.
- Last season, PFL teams claimed four wins against their FCS scholarship counterparts. Butler (at Murray State), Dayton (vs. Saint Francis), Drake (at Eastern Washington), and San Diego (vs. Cal Poly). Those victories helped the league post its most wins against FCS nonconference teams since 2019.
- Seven PFL alumni were on NFL 53-man rosters during Week 1. In addition, PFL alumni were on the rosters of the Canadian Football League and the United Football League during their respective 2025 seasons.

### OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK



#### **Matt Colombo, San Diego**

Graduate, Running Back, El Segundo, California

Colombo's three-yard touchdown run in overtime capped his impressive day as he led San Diego to a 30-27 victory against nationally-ranked Southern Utah on Saturday. He posted the PFL's first 200-yard rushing performance of 2025, amassing 202 net yards on 34 carries, including the game winner. Colombo was responsible for 10 of San Diego's 18 first downs. He also had a five-yard touchdown reception in the victory.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



#### **Vincent Firenze, Dayton**

Sophomore (RS), Safety, Syracuse, New York

Firenze led a Dayton unit that tossed a shutout in a 38-0 victory against Division II Thomas More on Saturday. He recorded six tackles (two solo) and also had an interception and a pass breakup. Firenze's interception came on the first play of a Thomas More drive and led to Dayton's first touchdown. His pass breakup came on a third-down play, forcing a punt in the third quarter. Dayton held Thomas More to 200 offensive yards, 11 first downs, and a 2-of-11 third-down conversion rate.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK



#### **Luke Green, Butler**

Sophomore (RS), Defensive Lineman, Pelham, New York

Green blocked two PATs in Butler's 37-27 victory against Truman State on Saturday. His second blocked kick came with Truman State threatening to tie the game 28-28. Instead, the blocked kick was recovered by defensive back Will Mason, who returned it 95 yards for a defensive two-point conversion, giving Butler a 30-27 lead.

### OTHER NOTABLE PERFORMANCES

#### **OFFENSIVE**

- Butler quarterback Andrew Reagan was responsible for four touchdowns in a 37-27 victory against Truman State. He completed 14-of-17 passes for 156 yards and two touchdowns and ran 13 times for 34 net yards and two touchdowns.
- Dayton running back Luke Hansen notched his 1,000th career rushing yard in a 15-carry, 131 net yard rushing performance that included two touchdown runs in a 38-0 victory against Thomas More.
- Marist quarterback Sonny Mannino finished with 311 total offensive yards in Marist's loss to Bucknell. He completed 22-of-42 passes for 229 yards and a touchdown and was the Red Foxes' leading rusher with 89 net yards on 20 carries.
- Presbyterian wide receiver Nathan Levicki caught both the touchdown and two-point conversion passes in overtime to secure a 39-38 victory at Furman. He finished the game with six receptions for 60 yards and two touchdowns, scoring 14 points.
- St. Thomas quarterback Andy Peters completed 21-of-29 passes for 264 yards and three touchdowns as St. Thomas pushed nationally-ranked Idaho before falling. He also rushed for 79 net yards on 11 carries, finishing the day with 343 total offensive yards.
- Stetson quarterback Kael Alexander picked up his first win as a starter, completing 11-of-15 passes for 336 yards and three touchdowns in a 59-13 victory against Warner.

#### **DEFENSIVE**

- Butler defensive back Will Mason had eight tackles (four solo) and recovered a blocked PAT and returned it 95 yards for a defensive two-point conversion in Butler's 37-27 victory against Truman State.
- Presbyterian defensive back Alex Ward finished with five tackles (two solo), with two for loss, including a sack, and a pass breakup as Presbyterian held Furman to three points over the final 24 minutes of regulation in a 39-38 overtime win at Furman.
- San Diego linebacker Nate Fischer posted 12 tackles (five solo), including 1.5 for loss and a sack, and a pass breakup in San Diego's 30-27 overtime victory against nationally-ranked Southern Utah.
- Stetson defensive back Simeon White II intercepted two passes in a 59-13 victory against Warner.
- Valparaiso linebacker Anthony Geltrini had 14 tackles (six solo), including one for loss, in a loss to Adrian.

## NOTES FROM ACROSS THE LEAGUE

### BLUE HOSE CLOSE TO TOP 25

After their back-to-back wins against Southern Conference foes, including a season-opening win against Mercer, Presbyterian is just on the outside of the Top 25 in both the Perform Stats and AFCA Coaches Polls. The Blue Hose have 100 points in the Perform Stats poll, 10 points away from the Top 25 and 27th overall. In the coaches poll, Presbyterian has 25 points and is 21 away from a ranking while being listed 28th overall.

### STETSON'S ALEXANDER WEEK 2 NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Stetson freshman quarterback Kael Alexander picked up the PFL's first national honor of 2025, claiming the Stats Perform FCS National Freshman of the Week award after Week 2's action. Alexander picked up his first win as a starter, completing 11-of-15 passes for 336 yards and three touchdowns in a 59-13 victory against Warner on Sept. 6. Six of his 11 completions went for 40 yards or more, including a 65-yard touchdown pass. Alexander's performance gave Stetson first-year head coach Mike Jasper his first victory.

### SAN DIEGO NOTCHES PFL'S SECOND WIN VS. NATIONALLY-RANKED FOE

San Diego stunned No. 24 Southern Utah in overtime on September 6 in San Diego, California, giving the PFL its second win against a ranked FCS opponent in 2025. It is the first time since 2000 the league has two wins against Top 25 FCS teams. It was San Diego's third win against a ranked team, joining wins against Cal Poly in 2016 and Northern Arizona in 2017 – both victories in the FCS Playoffs.

### PRESBYTERIAN KNOCKS OFF NATIONALLY-RANKED FCS OPPONENT

Presbyterian stunned No. 11 Mercer on August 30 at Five Star Stadium in Macon, Georgia. It was the PFL's fourth victory against a ranked FCS opponent since 2010 and first since Butler defeated Youngstown State to open the 2018 season. It snapped the PFL's 27-game losing streak to ranked FCS opposition.

### PFL OWNS FIVE WINS AGAINST THE FCS IN 2025

With Presbyterian and San Diego's victories in Week 2, the PFL has five wins against FCS opposition in 2025. Presbyterian's two wins against the Southern Conference equal the PFL's win total against the SoCon since 2025. San Diego's win against Southern Utah was the league's first against the United Athletic Conference. The PFL also picked up wins against the Ohio Valley Conference (St. Thomas over Lindenwood) and the Northeast Conference (Marist over New Haven).

The five wins are the league's most since 2019 and a sixth win would be the league's most since 2009. The league record for most wins against FCS teams in a season since 2000 is 10 set during the 2001 season.

### FOUR FIRST-YEAR HEAD COACHES HAVE WINS

Four of the league's five new head coaches have recorded a win in their new home through two weeks. First, it was Drake's Joe Woodley and Valparaiso's Andy Waddle who picked up wins in their Week 1 debuts. Week 2 action saw Butler's Kevin Lynch and Stetson's Mike Jasper pick up their first victories.

### SAN DIEGO RETURNS TO PFL PRESEASON #1 FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2019

For the first time since 2019, the league's head coaches tapped San Diego as the preseason favorite in the PFL 2025 Preseason Coaches Poll.

San Diego picked up five first-place votes and was not ranked lower than third by any of the league's head coaches to earn the poll's top spot with 94 points.

Drake, the 2024 PFL Champion, was first on three ballots and was selected in the top three on six ballots, earning second place in the poll with 78 points. St. Thomas, with 72 points, including a first-place vote, was third with 72 points.

### RETURNING TWO-TIME ALL-PFL SELECTION DOMINIC KIBBY HIGHLIGHTS 2025 PRESEASON ALL-PFL TEAM

Presbyterian College junior wide receiver Dominic Kibby is one of seven returning First Team All-PFL selections to be highlighted on the 2025 Pioneer Football League Preseason Team, announced in July.

Kibby, who is a two-time First Team All-PFL honoree, returns with 95 receptions and 1,479 receiving yards to his credit in his first two seasons with the Blue Hose. He was joined on the preseason team by a pair of teammates: graduate student wide receiver Cincere Gill and sophomore quarterback Collin Hurst. Presbyterian also has returning First Team All-PFL selections in defensive lineman Carter Szydiowski, defensive back Caleb Francis, and return specialist Zach Switzer.

There are three other returning 2024 First Team All-PFL selections on the preseason squad. Davidson running back Mari Adams and fullback Mason Sheron, as well as Marist offensive lineman Dominic Perricone. In addition, both of the PFL's 2024 Freshmen of the Year return in Hurst and Marist linebacker James Kratochvil.

**ST. THOMAS GAINS FULL-FLEDGED DIVISION I STATUS**

Following a vote by the NCAA Division I Board of Directors in June, the University of St. Thomas has officially completed the reclassification process, making it an active member of NCAA Division I and eligible to compete in NCAA championships.

The Tommies, who became the first institution to reclassify from Division III directly to Division I, won the 2022 Pioneer Football League title and finished among the league's top three teams in each of their first four seasons. Under head coach Glenn Caruso, St. Thomas has compiled a 31-14 (.689) record in four seasons as a Division I program, including a 26-6 (.812) record in PFL play. The Tommies have also seen their student-athletes earn 29 All-PFL honors..

**QUINTET OF NEW COACHES**

The PFL's coaching ranks continued to experience turnover during the 2024-25 offseason, with five head coaches hired. Butler, Davidson, Drake, Stetson, and Valparaiso all brought aboard new leaders for their programs. The turnover makes St. Thomas head coach Glenn Caruso the longest-serving head coach in the PFL as he begins his fifth PFL season with the Tommies (16th overall). Presbyterian's Steve Englehart is next at four seasons. **See PFL Coaching Records on page 7.**

**DAVIDSON'S ADAMS NAMED TO 2025 WALTER PAYTON AWARD PRE-SEASON WATCH LIST**

Davidson College senior running back Mari Adams was one of 30 student-athletes named to the 30-player preseason watch list for the 2025 Walter Payton Award, presented annually by Stats Perform to the national offensive player of the year in Division I FCS college football. Adams, from Shelby, North Carolina, was a Stats Perform Preseason Third-Team selection earlier this month after a First Team All-PFL campaign in 2024 that saw him rank among the FCS leaders in rushing yards (1,231 yards, 13th), rushing yards per game (111.9 ypg, 5th), and rushing touchdowns (15 TDs, 11th). He enters 2025 having rushed for 2,368 yards and 31 touchdowns during his career.

**DRAKE LINEBACKER ALLISON AMONG NATIONAL STANDOUTS AS MEMBER OF 2025 BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD PRESEASON WATCH LIST**

Drake senior linebacker Sean Allison has received national recognition as one of 30 student-athletes named to the 2025 Buck Buchanan Award Preseason Watch List. Allison, a Hinsdale, Illinois native, returns as a 2024 Second Team All-PFL selection, tallying 105 total tackles last season —the second-most among the Bulldogs' roster —with 5.5 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks, plus an interception and two quarterback hurries.

**TWO PFL ATHLETES NAMED TO 2025 STATS PERFORM FCS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA TEAM**

Drake long snapper Brett Welsing and Davidson College running back Mari Adams were named to the 2025 Stats Perform FCS Preseason All-America Team, with Adams later being named to the Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List (see above). Welsing, a senior from De Pere, Wisconsin, was a preseason second-team selection after earning First Team All-PFL honors at long snapper last season. He has played in all 23 games during the past two seasons for the Bulldogs, also earning Second Team All-PFL recognition in 2023.

**80 PFL STUDENT-ATHLETES NAMED TO 2025 NFF HAMPSHIRE HONOR SOCIETY**

In April, the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) announced the 2025 NFF Hampshire Honor Society members, with 80 Pioneer Football League student-athletes among the record-breaking 2,536 who qualified for membership. Marist led all PFL institutions with 19 student-athletes recognized. Dayton (14), Davidson (5), Drake (11), Morehead State (5), St. Thomas (11), and Valparaiso (15) also saw student-athletes named to the Hampshire Honor Society. Members of the NFF Hampshire Society are seniors or graduate college football players from all divisions of the NCAA, NAIA, and Spring Football who maintained a cumulative 3.2 GPA or better during their college careers.

**TOREROS ALUMNUS JOSH JOHNSON'S WELL-TRAVELED NFL CAREER**

San Diego alumnus Josh Johnson, who was drafted in the fifth round of the 2008 NFL Draft, was signed by the Washington Commanders during the offseason and is vying for a roster spot in the 2025 season. In the 17 seasons since that draft, he has played for an NFL-record 14 different teams (according to The New York Times/The Athletic). Johnson has played as a starter for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, Washington Redskins (now Commanders), and the Baltimore Ravens. He has also been on the roster with the San Francisco 49ers, Cleveland Browns, Cincinnati Bengals, New York Jets, Indianapolis Colts, Buffalo Bills, New York Giants, Houston Texans, Oakland Raiders, Detroit Lions, and Denver Broncos. Entering 2025, he has completed 208-of-358 passes for 2,297 yards and 13 touchdowns.
