Research shows that up to 65% of entry-level nurse errors are related to poor clinical decision-making. The National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) set out to understand this gap between education and practice and reported several findings:

23%

Only 23% of new nursing graduates have the entry-level competencies they need.

50%

50% of entry-level nurses are involved in practice errors.

20%

Only 20% of employers are satisfied with the decision-making abilities of entry-level nurses.
