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Background

Driven by a commitment to innovative education and feedback from 2023, we reimagined our Annual Mandatory Education.

This program replaces traditional lectures with an engaging escape room experience, designed to boost team collaboration, knowledge retention, and overall satisfaction.

Objective

- At the end of the Escape Room, team members will:
- Complete training requirements with improved team member satisfaction.
 - Meet annual education requirements in an engaging setting.

Methods

- Line A** Needs assessments and Joint Commission standards informed the design of two escape rooms— for PCAs and for RNs.
- Top Infer** Interactive puzzles and clues engaged participants with critical topics.
- Administrat** Debriefings reinforced learning and gathered feedback. Leadership ensured alignment with educational goals and regulations.

Conclusions



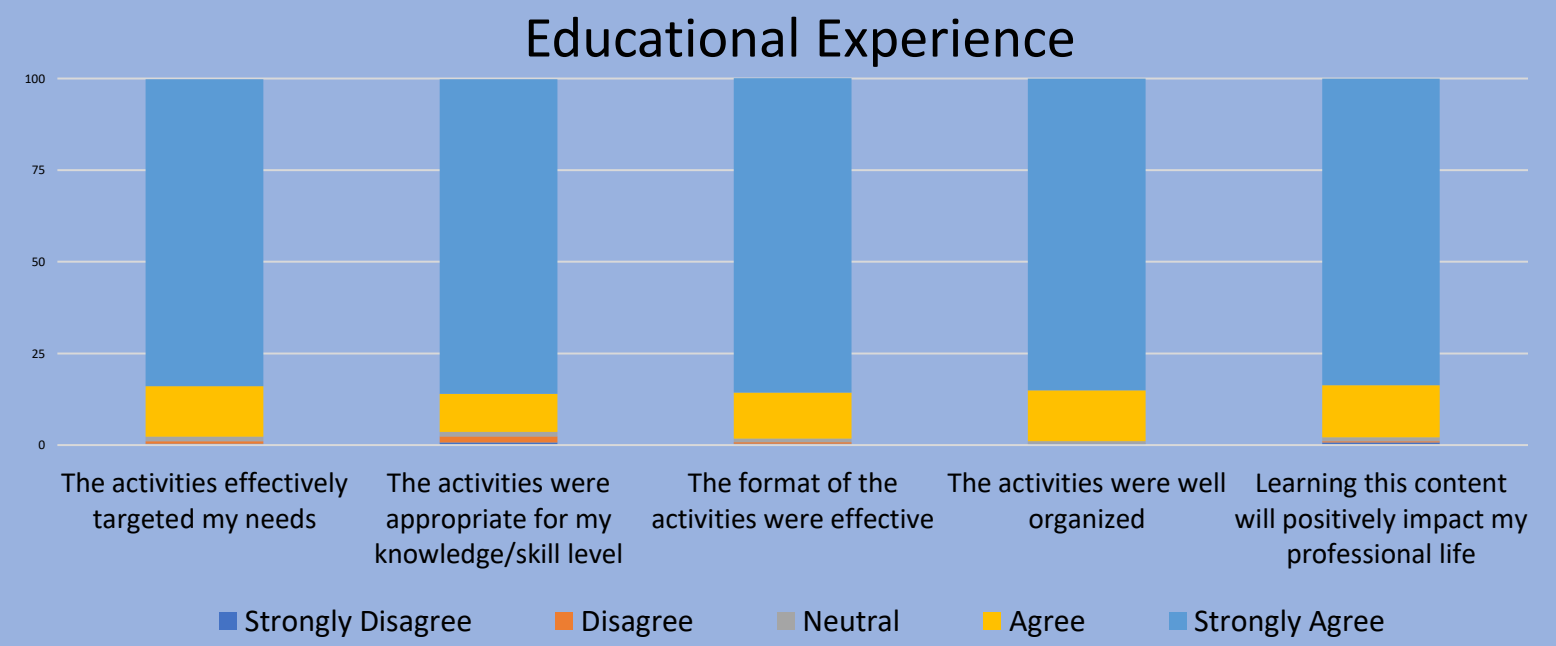
This innovative escape room approach to Annual Mandatory Education has demonstrably enhanced engagement and outcomes.



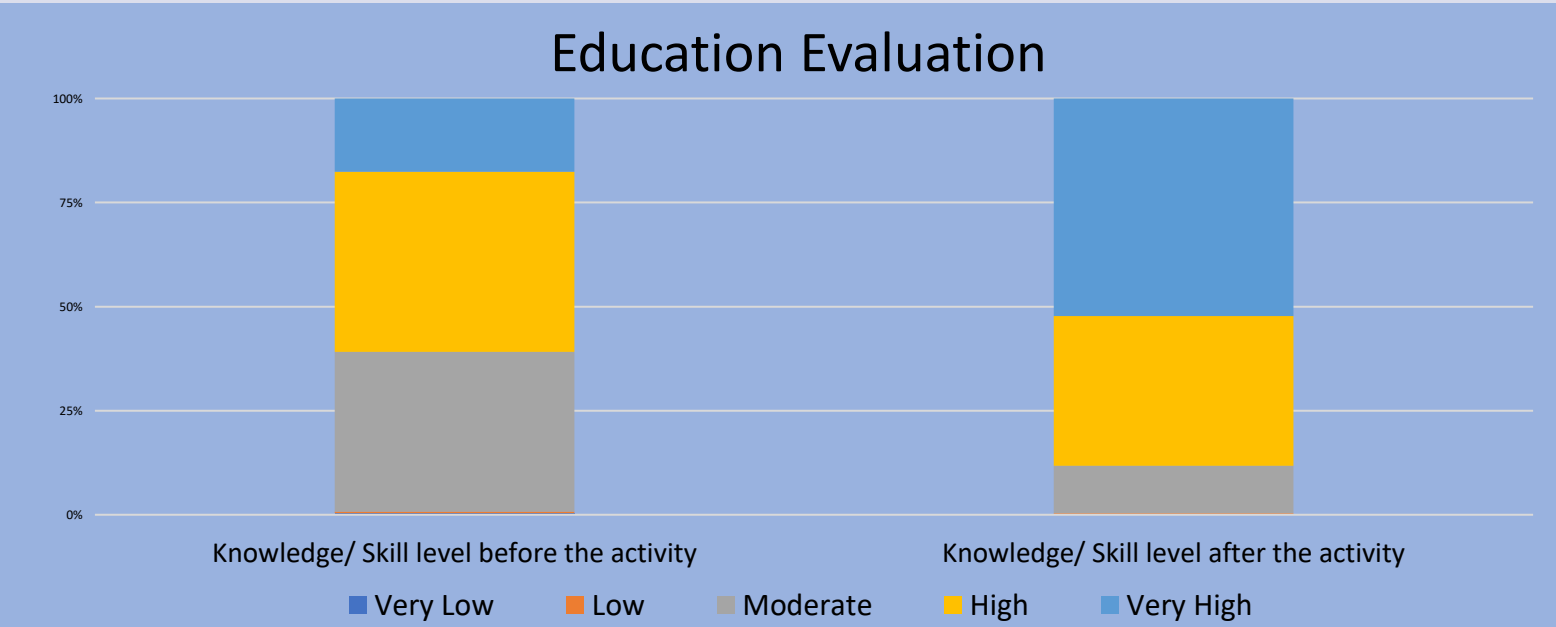
Continual refinement promises an even more impactful and enriching learning experience and design to capture knowledge retention.

Results

With 94% of participants rating the experience as "excellent," our 2024 escape room sessions evidently enhanced teamwork, leadership, and active engagement.



Post-session observations and debriefings confirm effective knowledge retention and understanding, validating this innovative approach to mandatory education.
