The collection covered the "Trans-Allegheny West" which included the western Carolinas and Virginia, some portions of Georgia and Alabama, the entire Ohio River valley, and parts of the Mississippi River valley, prior to 1830.

The State Historical Society of Wisconsin made the collection available to researchers through microfilm. There are 3 editions of the microfilm: the 1949 edition, replaced by the new microfilm edition in 1980, and the 1981 microfiche edition.

The Draper Collection includes: Letters, miscellaneous legal documents, journals, diaries, family and personal records, land records, muster rolls, order books, court martial lists, interviews of pioneers, etc., together with notes and correspondence of

To Use:

The collection was organized into 491 volumes divided into 50 series of varying lengths, arranged by geographic area, subject, and individual. The primary tool used to access materials within the collection is Josephine Harper's book Guide to the Draper Manuscripts. The Wisconsin Historical Society also produced several volumes of indexes called the "Calendars Series" to research collection. The Draper Manuscripts have been given an alphabetical designation or pressmark. **SAGHS** provides many of the indexes to this collection.
