

Steve Feller has passed away



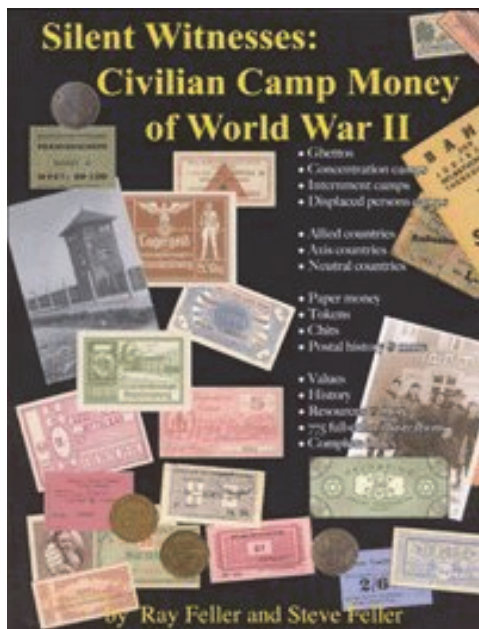
The SPMC is saddened to learn that member Steve Feller passed away on November 19, 2025 while attending a Society of Physics Students conference in Denver, CO.

Steve was born on January 12, 1951 in Brooklyn, NY. He was the director of the physics department at Coe College in Cedar Rapids, IA.

Steve was member #5494 of the SPMC joining the society in 1979. He was a researcher and frequent author with over 30 articles attributed to him. He was best well known for his research and writing about internment money in WWII. He also was making a census of T-64 notes that will be continued by Mark Coughlan.

He was the author with his daughter Ray of *"Silent Witnesses: Civilian Camp Money of WWII."*

Steve was awarded many SPMC literary awards for the articles he authored and an ANA Presidents Award in 2004. He and his daughter Ray were named Numismatic Ambassadors in 2017.
