Our response was to launch our Online Campus. Over the first 3 weeks over 61,000 viewers joined us online for worship. A dedicated team of online ministers formed and we were reminded that God hears all prayers — even if they are through a chat room.



Staying Connected

In a season when isolation ruled, our staff worked tirelessly to make connections. We found solutions for small groups that allowed them to meet via video, and created space online to find guidance from the Word on how to navigate the difficult season. We even personally called all 13,270 people to check in on them and see how their church family could support them.


