The process should be seamless for TALP clients. "TALP volunteers interview our service members, then the stories and pictures are entered into the members' StorySite," Frasier said. "In a short time, the service member has his or her own book to share with family and friends."

What's next? TALP's goal is to help 300 service members and veterans save their stories in the next 5 years. TALP volunteers are busy accepting donations, and receiving contacts from service members who want to save their stories.
