18 years of age



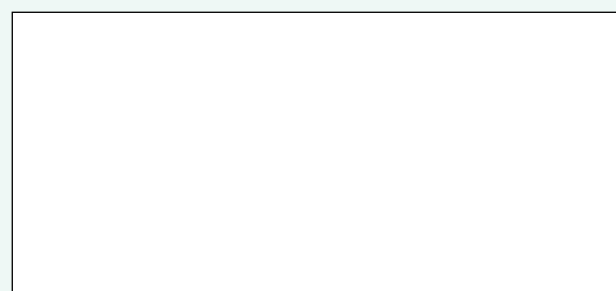
Have been
