



Accessing your HKPropel digital product is easy!

If it's your first time using HKPropel:

1. Visit HKPropel.HumanKinetics.com.
2. Click the "[New user? Register here](#)" link on the opening screen to register for an account and redeem your one-time-use access code.
3. Follow the onscreen prompts to create your HKPropel account. Use a **valid email address** as your username to ensure you receive important system updates and to help us find your account if you ever need assistance.
4. Enter the access code exactly as shown below, including hyphens. You will not need to re-enter this access code on subsequent visits, and this access code cannot be redeemed by any other user.
5. After your first visit, simply log in to HKPropel.HumanKinetics.com to access your digital product.

If you already have an HKPropel account:

1. Visit HKPropel.HumanKinetics.com and log in with your username (email address) and password.
2. Once you are logged in, click the arrow next to your name in the top right corner and then click **My Account**.
3. Under the "Add Access Code" heading, enter the access code exactly as shown below, including hyphens, and click the **Add** button.
4. Once your code is redeemed, navigate to your Library on the Dashboard to access your digital content.
